



Caravan site Rules and guidelines:

As a guest at Box End Park we would appreciate it if you could observe the following rules:

Arrival

All guests must have pre booked a pitch and arranged an arrival time. Please park in the main car park and register at the main reception before siting your van. Payment must be made in full at time of arrival.

If the main reception is closed on arrival, please call 07922 824678

Allocation of pitch

On arrival you will be allocated a pitch number. Please ensure that you site your van within the immediate vicinity of the numbered pitch post. As a guest you can site a Van or campervan, one car and an awning. Any additional cars must be parked in the main car park area.

Pitches should be left clean and tidy on departure.

Noise

Noise must be kept to an absolute minimum on the site. No independent sound systems, shouting or rowdy behaviour are permitted. If any disturbances are caused, offending parties will be asked to leave the park immediately with no refunds.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome on the site, however, they must be kept on a lead at all times, and never left unattended.

Much of Box End Park is a barefoot area, it is therefore vital that owners are responsible for clearing up any fouling that takes place on the site.

Vehicles

A 10mph speed limit is in place within the Box End Park. Please ensure this is respected and avoid unnecessary vehicle movement, especially at night time.

The main gates are locked at night as a security measure. If you require entry or exit from the site between 23:00 - 08:00, please speak to reception when checking in.

Guests

A pitch is permitted to accommodate 2 adults and up to 3 children. Any additional visitors who are staying over night will be charged at £5 per night. This should be paid at the time of checking in.

Waste Disposal

The contents of chemical toilets must be emptied at the disposal point (at the back right hand corner of the toilet block).

Disposable nappies and similar bulky items must not be emptied into the chemical toilet emptying point.

Waste Water

A suitable receptacle, which should not be allowed to overflow, must be used for the collection of waste water and emptied at the disposal point provided.

Disposal of Rubbish

All waste paper and other solid refuse should be deposited in the bins provided for the purpose.

Rubbish should be separated for recycling wherever possible

Barbecues / Fires

All barbecues must be raised sufficiently off the ground to minimise the risk of fire and to avoid damage to grass areas. Please endeavour to minimise smoke and fumes

No open fires are permitted on the site. There is a fire safety point immediately outside the toilet block

Vacation of Pitches

Pitches should normally be vacated by 12 noon.
